After School Club Childcare:

I am delighted to announce that a successful application and interview process, we have now appointed a new play worker to lead and run our new after school provision. Mrs Johnston joins us from Monday 6th November bringing a wealth of childcare and play provision experience. We thank our families for their patience in bearing with us whilst we made the correct appointment for the after school club.

I can now share the following information about the after school club:

- The after school club is a childcare provision for our families
- The club will run from 3.00 5.45pm and will be based in our Community Room
- The club is open to all children from Reception Year 6
- At the club children will be provided with a snack, refreshments and a range of activities such as art and craft, baking, role play and many more
- The cost is £9.00 per session which covers staffing, snacks and activities
- Payments can be made using cash or cheque
- Bookings and payments for the after school club will be expected to be made to the school office a week in advance in order to secure a place

If you would like more information about the after school club, Mrs Johnston and Mrs Carroll will be available in the school hall on Parents' Evening to answer any of your questions. We will also be taking bookings for the week beginning Monday 6^{th} November.
